To Parent, Teacher & Employee Organizations:

The Mt. Laurel Twp. Board of Education has contracted with Environmental Remediation & Management Inc. to act as their "Designated Person" as defined under the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986. AHERA required that all educational facilities be inspected for asbestos – containing materials and develop a remedial plan of action on or before May 9, 1989. In addition, each educational facility shall reassess all identified asbestos – containing materials or materials assumed to be asbestos, at least once every six months (periodic surveillance) and re-inspect those facilities every three years.

The Mt. Laurel Twp. Board of Education is in compliance with these requirements. The most recent Tri-annual re-inspection was performed in June of, 2014. "Periodic Surveillance" inspections are performed every June and December. The latest inspection was June of this summer, with the next one scheduled for December, 2016.

Following each inspection, appropriate remedial actions are recommended to the Board of Education by an accredited Asbestos Management Planner. The remedial plans of action and recommended schedules for implementation (Asbestos Management Plans) are available for review at the Mt. Laurel Board of Education Administrative Office, as well as in each school office.

We will continue to keep you informed of our AHERA compliance.
