Fri., Nov. 20: District-wide Afternoon Conferences (K-8)

Mon., Nov. 23: Evening Conferences (Prek-4); Afternoon Conf. (5th to 8th)

Tues., Nov. 24: Evening Conferences (5th to 8th); Afternoon Conf. (K-4)

The specific times for afternoon conferences are specific to your child(ren)'s school(s). When you log into your new PTC Wizard Account the conference times will be displayed. Evening conferences are held from 6 to 8 PM.

Remember to continue to review the [Daily Health Screener](#) each morning before sending your child to school. If your child is sick keep them home! Call your School Nurse and report all absences.

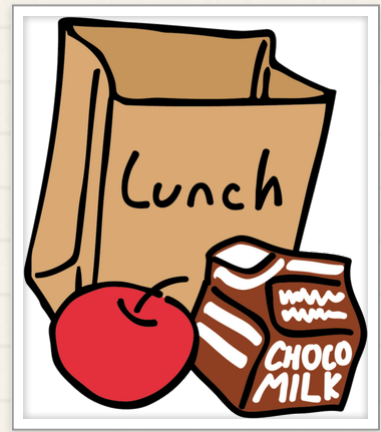
