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SCHOOL ORGANIZATION

The Mount Laurel Township School District Board of Education directs the organization of the instructional program of this district in the following schools and grades:

<b>Schools</b>	<b>Grades</b>
Countryside School	Kindergarten through 4
Fleetwood School	Kindergarten through 4
Hillside School	Kindergarten through 4
Larchmont School	Kindergarten through 4
Parkway School	Kindergarten through 4
Hartford School	5 and 6
T.E. Harrington Middle School	7 and 8

Grades 7 and 8 are to be organized for the provision of departmentalized instruction.

The chief school administrator shall continually monitor the effectiveness of the district organizational plan and recommend to the board such modifications in the plan as may be in the best interest of pupils, make most effective use of district resources, and serve the educational goals of the board.
