

GRADING SYSTEM

The Board recognizes that a system of grading student achievement can help the student, teachers, and parents to assess better the student's progress toward personal educational goals and assist the student in the implementation of that progress.

Grading shall be that system of measuring and recording student progress and achievement, which enables the student, parents and teachers to:

- a. learn the student's strengths and weaknesses
- b. plan an educational future for the student in the areas of the greatest potential for success
- c. know where remedial work is required.

Such grades shall measure the students' progress against both their own potential for achievement and the achievements of others in their class as appropriate to the grade level and subject matter.

The Board directs that the instructional program of this district include a system of grading for grades K to 8, which is consistent with the educational goals of the district.
