 - behavioral issues with students punching, kicking, choking other students;
 - teachers have also been assaulted by students
 - Multiple occasions of classes having to evacuate their classroom while a student is de-escalated (disrupts 2 classrooms and continuity of education)
- Many other parents echoed their concerns about the overall climate and culture of Fleetwood with regards to the misbehaviors of students.
 - Parents are concerned that the misbehaviors seem to be increasing in frequency and intensity.

- Parents would like to know the protocols and policies for handling students' misbehaviors.
- Parents would like to know the protocols and policies for being notified about these incidents that directly and indirectly affect our children.
- PTO is more than willing to offer support in any ways we possibly can (financial, etc.)
- We would like to request an open forum meeting with Mr. DeSimone and Dr. Rafferty so we can discuss our concerns and secure information about protocols and policies.
