Celebrating Juneteenth

Known also as African American Independence Day, Jubilee Day, or Freedom Day, Juneteenth is a celebration of the emancipation of enslaved Black people in America. The reason why the holiday is specifically celebrated on June 19th is because on June 19, 1865, Union General Gordon Granger informed the people of Galveston, Texas that the Civil War had ended and that all enslaved people were considered free. In Texas, Juneteenth has been an official holiday since 1979. In 2021, it was made a federal holiday. By 2019, 48 states including the District of Columbia recognized Juneteenth. By 2020, only Texas had adopted the holiday as a paid holiday for state employees. As of 2021, more states declared Juneteenth a paid holiday for state employees in Minnesota, Illinois, New York, Washington, and Virginia.

One way to celebrate Juneteenth is to have cookouts. Another way to celebrate Juneteenth is to serve red drinks. The red color symbolizes the blood shed by the slaves. You can also attend rodeos because the holiday originated in Texas. Attending street fairs is another popular method of celebrating Juneteenth. Slavery tore many families apart so family reunions are another way to celebrate. Juneteenth is such a wonderful holiday!

Father's Day

The nation's first Father's Day was celebrated on June 19, 1910, in the state of Washington. Its existence was created mostly to follow up Mother's Day and include fathers. The interesting thing

is that men didn't even like the holiday. According to one historian, men "scoffed at the holiday's sentimental attempts to domesticate manliness with flowers and gift-giving, or they derided the proliferation of such holidays as a commercial gimmick to sell more products—often paid for by the father himself."

Throughout the next couple of decades, there was a push to try to merge both holidays together to make Parent's Day. However, that time was during the great depression, and it was better for the economy if there were two separate holidays. When WWII began, advertisers brought patriotism into the rink, saying that celebrating Father's Day was a way to honor American troops and support the war effort. By the end of the war, Father's Day may not have been a federal holiday, but it was a national institution.

It was not until 1972—58 years after President Woodrow Wilson made Mother's Day official—that the day honoring fathers became a nationwide holiday in the United States. Father's Day 2023 will occur on Sunday, June 18. Today, economists estimate that Americans spend more than \$1 billion each year on Father's Day gifts.










Making a Milkshake, Because it is June Cosmo
