



Introducing International Harry Potter Day!

There's no better time to break out your wand and binge read the Harry Potter series than May 2. Created 15 years after the release of *Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone*, International Harry Potter Day is the official anniversary of the Battle of Hogwarts. On this day, 1998, Lord Voldemort is defeated in the final battle of the Second Wizarding War.



Surprisingly, this anniversary is not fanmade. In 2012, British prime minister David Cameron declared it an official holiday, saying, "In order to fully commemorate and immortalize her work, we have decided to officially declare May 2nd as an official international holiday, in honor of the date that protagonist Harry Potter conquered the main antagonist of the series, Lord Voldemort."

More than two decades after the initial release of the books, the series still has an enormous impact on everyone's childhood. And with more than 500 million copies sold, and the Guinness World Record for highest-selling series by a single author, it's no wonder.

There are theme parks, retail stores, fanfiction, escape rooms, and collections dedicated to Harry Potter, with millions of fans (Potterheads) worldwide.

"We hope that children and adults alike will be reminded of Harry Potter's strong and courageous character on this day, as well as of the true credit that Ms. Rowling has made to society," Cameron said.



An Introduction to Color Theory 2 By: Ellie S.

Continuation of An Introduction to Color Theory from the last edition of Paw Prints

Why are color schemes so important?

Referring back to the previous edition of An Introduction to Color Theory; opposite colors, aka complementary colors, make one another pop out, and pairing them together draws the attention of the human eye. Not only that but it is also aesthetically pleasing. But you don't have to pair complementary colors together to make something look nice or aesthetically pleasing. There are other color schemes that do this too.

- **Monochromatic**
 - Try pairing different shades of the same color together!
- Analogous
 - -Pick 3 colors right next to each other and match them together.
- Split Complementary
 - Pick a color, go to the opposite color on the color wheel and use the colors next to it.
- Triad
 - Divide the circle evenly into 3 different parts (make sure the

lines are overlapping on top of the colors on the wheel), and choose the colors where the lines overlap!

- Tetrad
 - _ Use two colors right next to each other and the colors opposite of each other
- Square
 - Similar to triad, divide the circle into 4 parts (make sure the lines are overlapping on top of the colors on the wheel), and choose the colors where the lines overlap!
